The subject was Enhancing Success in European-funded Research Proposals and the course addressed questions such as:

What sort of proposal is most likely to succeed in being awarded funding?

How can you write a proposal that presents your idea in a clear and convincing manner?

Topics addressed included:

- Review of EU RTD programmes/processes
- Preparation and finding an appropriate Call
- Developing a sound proposal in the required format for each of the key sections required
- Writing a proposal in clear English
- Considering the evaluators' perspective
- On-going management of successful projects

The three trainers involved in these courses had extensive experience of EU Research projects, through working in the European Commission, through participation in project reviews and evaluations, or through managing successful projects.
